Questions to Consider Asking When Visiting Colleges

(Look up this information on the website ahead of time so that you only need to ask questions that are not already answered.)

- 1. Admissions requirements:
 - a. Do you have an application deadline?
 - b. Is there a minimum SAT or ACT score?
 - c. Is there a foreign language requirement?
 - d. What are your science and math requirements?
 - e. How important is my GPA and class rank?
 - f. Is an essay required with the application? If not, does it help to send one?
 - g. Are recommendations from teachers and counselors needed or helpful?
- 2. Cost: What is the total expected cost for tuition, books, room & board and fees?
- 3. Financial Aid:
 - a. What types of financial aid are available at your college and how do I apply?
 - b. Will I be presented with a financial aid package when I am accepted, if I am accepted?
 - c. Are there any part time jobs available on campus?
- 4. Job Placement:
 - a. Do you have a job placement service if needed when I graduate?
 - b. What is your placement rate in their field of study for graduates?
- 5. Religion: With what religious group, if any, is the school affiliated? If none, is there a church of your choice near the college?
- 6. Extra Curricular Activities: What extra curricular activities such as clubs, sports, and organizations are available?
- 7. Academics:
 - a. What is the average class size?
 - b. Will I be able to talk today with any faculty members in my area of interest?
 - c. Is remedial help available if I should need it? For example, if I need extra help in math, is it available?
- 8. Car:
 - a. Can I bring a car to the campus?
 - b. What is the registration or parking cost to have a car?
